

BTLTC Club Rules

COURT AVAILABILITY – ALL COURTS ARE AVAILABLE TO MEMBERS EXCEPT WHEN IN USE FOR COACHING OR MATCHES. MATCH DATES ARE SHOWN ON THE BOARD AT THE BACK OF THE CLUBHOUSE. 2 COURTS WILL BE IN USE FROM 6.15PM FOR ADULT MATCHES. JUNIOR MATCHES (3 COURTS) TAKE PLACE ON SOME SUNDAYS – SEE NOTICEBOARD.

REGULAR COACHING TIMES ARE SHOWN ON THE BOARD AT THE BACK OF THE CLUBHOUSE AND ON THE WEBSITE – GENERALLY 4-7PM MONDAY TO FRIDAY FOR JUNIORS PLUS SATURDAYS 9-12 PM AND TUESDAYS 6.30-8PM FOR ADULT BACK TO TENNIS SESSIONS (3 COURTS ARE IN USE ON SATURDAY 9-12 NOON, MONDAY 6-7PM AND TUESDAY 6.30-8PM).

SOME DAYTIME JUNIOR GROUP SESSIONS ARE ARRANGED FOR SCHOOL HOLIDAYS AND SOME SCHOOLS COACHING SESSIONS ARE ARRANGED FOR THE SPRING TERM – SEE NOTICEBOARD.

IN ADDITION THE BACK COURT IS AVAILABLE TO THE COACH FOR INDIVIDUAL COACHING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FRIDAYS 9-11am (LEAVING 2 COURTS FREE), SO IF PLAYING ON THIS COURT YOU MAY BE ASKED TO VACATE IT IN WHICH CASE YOU WILL BE ABLE TO PLAY ON ONE OF THE OTHER COURTS FOLLOWING THE RULES BELOW.

CLUB NIGHTS ARE FROM 7PM MONDAYS AND THURSDAYS (GENERALLY 2 OR 3 COURTS DEPENDING ON NUMBERS).

OTHERS WAITING WHEN ALL COURTS ARE IN USE. THOSE PLAYING SHOULD FINISH A SHORT SET – ADULTS FIRST TO 6 GAMES/JUNIORS FIRST TO 4 GAMES (AND NO LONGER THAN 30 MINUTES), AND LET THOSE WAITING ON TO PLAY A SHORT SET, ETC.

FOOTWEAR – ONLY NON MARKING TENNIS/COURT SHOES TO BE WORN

CLOTHING – ONLY SUITABLE SPORTS CLOTHING TO BE WORN

DRINKS – ONLY WATER/ WATER BASED DRINKS TO BE TAKEN ONTO COURT. NO GLASS BOTTLES.

CHEWING GUM – NONE TO BE TAKEN ONTO COURTS

CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS – TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT

VISITORS – MUST SIGN AND DATE THE VISITORS BOOK AND PAY A FEE OF £4 EACH FOR ADULTS UNACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER OR £3 EACH IF ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER AND £2 EACH FOR STUDENTS OR JUNIORS INTO THE CASH BOX UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 6 SESSIONS BEFORE JOINING THE CLUB

GENERAL BEHAVIOUR – THERE CAN BE NO DEFENCE FOR AGGRESSIVE OR ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR FROM ANYONE INVOLVED IN THE CLUB. A DISCIPLINARY CODE IS IN PLACE UNDER THE CLUB CONSTITUTION AND A MEMBER MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE CLUB IF UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR PERSISTS
